Village of Donnelly PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BYLAW 2021-03

BEING A BYLAW OF VILLAGE OF DONNELLY TO IMPOSE PENALTIES ON UNPAID TAXES AND TAX ARREARS

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Act M-26 authorizes Council to impose penalties in the year in which a tax is imposed if the tax remains unpaid after the due date shown on the tax notice; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act authorizes Council to impose penalties in any year following the year in which a tax is imposed if the tax remains unpaid after December 31 of the year which it is imposed (tax arrears);

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Village of Donnelly, in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS

- 1. "Tax Year" means the annual period in which taxes are imposed, commencing with January 1 and ending with December 31;
- 2. "Taxes" means taxes imposed in the Tax Year;
- 3. "Tax Arrears" means all taxes which remain unpaid after December 31 of any Tax Year.

PENALTIES

- 4. Taxes paid after the due date shown on the tax notice shall be subject to penalties imposed in accordance with the Bylaw.
- 5. Taxes or any portion thereof that remain unpaid after the due date shown on the tax notice shall have penalties imposed on the dates and at the rates specified below:

August 1 ten percent (10%)

6. Tax Arrears or any portion thereof that remain unpaid shall have penalties imposed on the dates and the rates specified below;

> fifteen percent (15%) January 1

REPEAL AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third reading.
