1. A vote to elect a nominee for Senate. You will asked to select three (3) names from a list of 13 candidates
2. Two (2) referendum questions—you will be asked to vote **YES** or **NO**
  - a. Should Section 26(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982—Parliament and Government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments—be removed from the Constitution?
  - b. Do you want Alberta to adopt year round Daylight Saving Time; which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?
