BYLAW 24-02

BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE PROVISION OF GOODS AND SERVICES WITHIN VILLAGE OF DONNELLY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000 Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, a municipality has the authority to establish fees and charges for the provision of goods and services; and

WHEREAS the Council of Village of Donnelly wishes to establish certain fees and charges; NOW THEREFORE the Council of Village of Donnelly, duly assembled and under the authority of the Municipal Government Ac., as amended, hereby enacts the following:

TITLE

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Fees and Charges Bylaw"

APPLICATION

2. This bylaw establishes rates, fees and charges for certain goods and services provided by THE Village of Donnelly.
3. All fees are non-refundable unless otherwise noted, and all fees include GST unless otherwise noted.
4. Where any fees establish in any other Bylaw of Village outline a different fee or charge than established in this bylaw. This bylaw shall be the charge applicable for the related level of service.

SCHEDULES

5. The fees payable by persons accessing services from Village of Donnelly are those fees set out in the Fees & Charges Schedule .


ENACTMENT/TRANSITION

6. Should any provision of this bylaw be deemed invalid then such invalid provision will be severed from this bylaw and such severance will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw, except to the extent necessary to give effect to such severance.
7. Upon third and final reading of this Bylaw 22-02 shall be rescinded
8. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of third reading and signing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2024.

READ A SECOND TIME this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2024.

READ A THIRD TIME and finally passed this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2024.
